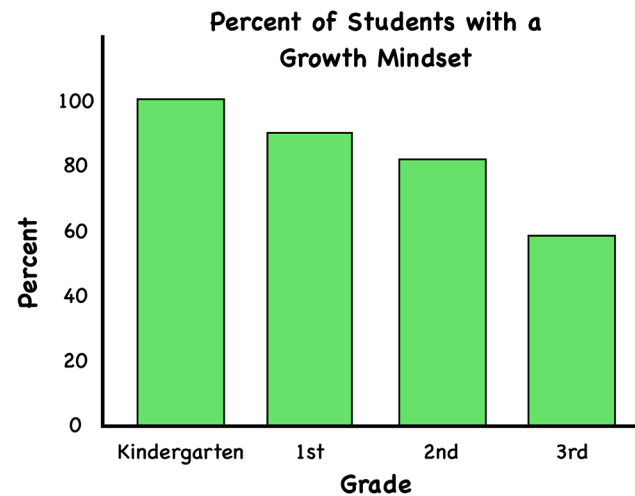
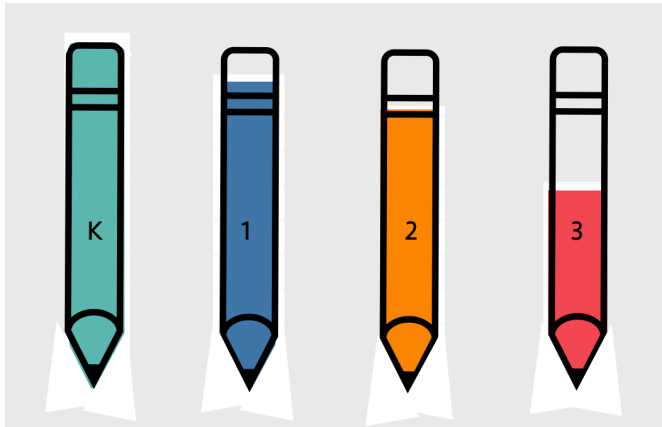


## Youcubed Data Talk Growth Mindset
